Job title: Site Engineer
Reports to: Construction Manager
Job purpose: Under the supervision of the Construction Manager, the Site Engineer provides technical expertise to execute assigned construction projects with support from other colleagues and management.

Key responsibilities

The Site Engineer shall:

- ▶ Supervise works on site without compromising on quality, time and cost.
- ▶ Check for technical aspects of project including designs and specification and ensure the information is correct and up to date.
- ▶ Liaise with the consultants to ensure they are updated on any technical developments on site.
- ▶ Ensure all necessary material tests and samples are conducted and approved before commencement of such activities.
- ▶ Keep track of construction work programme while taking note of changes and reporting them to the Site Manager.
- ▶ Track changes to the design and make timely reporting of such changes.
- ▶ Liaise with the Site Manager and sub-contractors on all technical aspects of the project while ensuring project success is upheld.
- ▶ Provide technical advice to team members while displaying competence in problem solving.
- ▶ Execute quality control procedures on the project while utilising available systems of total quality management in construction.
- ▶ Participate in site surveys and setting out of the building accurately to the satisfaction of the consultants.
- ▶ Ensure that health and safety is maintained by facilitating a safe work environment for workers, visitors and third parties.
- ▶ Assist the Site Manager in preparation of schedules and ensuring that they are adhered to during the execution of the project.
- ▶ Ensure that all materials used and work performed are in accordance with the specifications.
- ▶ Perform any other duties and tasks as requested.

Required qualifications, competencies, personal attributes and experience

- ▶ University degree in Civil Engineering, Construction Management, Diploma in Civil Engineering or related course from a recognised University or higher institution of learning.
- ▶ At least 3–5 years' post graduate experience in the construction sector with a contractor, or 5–10 years' experience for Diploma holders.
- ▶ Good knowledge of MS Tools, AutoCAD and MS project.
- ▶ Demonstration of strong technical skills.
- ▶ Flexibility to work in a dynamic, diverse and challenging environment.

- ▶ Ability to Work independently.
- ▶ Excellent leadership and an ability to motivate your team to ensure a high standard of work under tight deadlines.
- ▶ Excellent planning and organisational skills for writing and monitoring project plans and schedules and utilising time and resources effectively.
- ▶ Problem solving skills as well as resilience to overcome unexpected challenges during the construction process.
- ▶ An ability to make decisions under pressure so that the project can progress.
- ▶ Strong attention to detail and managing complex projects.
- ▶ Demonstrated knowledge and awareness of health and safety procedures and legislation to run a healthy and safe construction site.
